REGULAR SPORTS SCHOLARSHIP POINT SYSTEM

The table below defines the points values for the competition results submitted for the ELTE TTK Regular Sports Scholarship and is based on the sports performance system of the Hungarian Olympic Committee (MOB). The points system applies to the fall semester of the 2026/2027 academic year.

The following rules apply to determine the scores:

a) Sports

Performance points can only be obtained in sports of sports associations accepted by the MOB. Sports not accepted by the MOB but which can be practiced under the BEAC flag (if they have such a category) are also awarded points, but in all cases the points corresponding to non-Olympic sports apply to them. A candidate can receive the maximum points for two of the results achieved in a given sport and level. For the next two, the candidate receives 0.8 times the original score, then for the next two (i.e. for the fifth and sixth results of the same type) the candidate receives 0.6 times the original score and so on. (So, for the 11th result of the same type [in a given sport and level], no points are awarded.)

Among the competition results of non-Olympic sports, if it is a competition at a lower level than national (e.g. regional, county), only results where there were at least 6 participating teams/competitors, in the category of the applicant, who not only registered but also competed in the given competition, can be applied for.

b) Levels of sports competitions

Where competitions and championships are organised in several classes at a given level (e.g. in Budapest football BLSZ 1, BLSZ 2, etc., or in national basketball NB1, NB1b), the score is for the highest class competition, at lower levels the multiplier is: 0.8; 0.6; 0.4 and 0.2 (e.g. the multiplier for BLSZ 3 is 0.6).

The points in the table apply to adult (elite, pro, etc. in international competitions) competitions of the given sport, in the case of youth age group competitions of levels 2-5 (e.g.

junior, U21, U23) the multiplier is: 0.8.

In the case of levels 2-5, where a separate “amateur” (international level: Age Group, Masters, etc.) category is announced (e.g. Amateur MEFOB, or Amateur Triathlon World Championships), the points must be multiplied by 0.5.

c) Competition season

In the case of sports where there are no mid-year individual results that can be judged (for example, the handball season), the overall championship result must be multiplied by 2.0.

d) Individual, pair and team sports

For both individual and pair sports, the points in the table must be taken into account, if it is an Olympic sport. The competition results of non-Olympic individual and pair sports are counted with a multiplier of 0.9.

In the case of team sports, the success points of championships and cups, if it is a non-Olympic sport, are counted with a multiplier of 0.7. In the case of team sports, only the result where the applicant participated in the given competition (not just as a member of the squad or as a reserve) and can prove this can be accepted. Where individual and team results are counted from the same activity, either the individual or the team result can be counted (not both).

e) University competitions

Results achieved in ELTE colours in domestic and international university competitions at levels 2-5 count with a multiplier of 1.25.
